At a meeting of the inhabitants of School Districts Numbers One and Four of the town of Brookhaven, in the County of Suffolk and State of New York, held at Union Hall, in said districts at Stony Brook in the town of Brookhaven aforesaid, on the 14th day of July 1896, at eight o'clock p. m. pursuant to a call of the trustees of said districts dated the 16th day of June 1896, for the purpose of determining by a vote of said districts whether a union free school should be established therein in conformity to the provisions of title eight, of chapter 588 of the laws of 1894 and the amendments thereto;

Charles W. Peterman was chosen chairman and Thomas Anderson secretary.

Thomas S. Mount offered the following resolution in writing, to wit: "Resolved that the two school districts at Stony Brook, known as Districts No. 1 and No. 4 of the town of Brookhaven, be consolidated by the establishment of a union free school therefor and therein."

It was then carried on motion that we proceed to vote upon said resolution by ballot. Captain Carlton Jayne and Chas. T. Berling were thereupon appointed tellers to receive and count the votes. After the polls were closed all having been given an opportunity to vote the following was the result of the vote and was so announced by the chairman, Total number of votes cast were 106, for the resolution, 83, and 23 against it.

A motion was then made and carried to proceed to the election of seven trustees.

A motion was made and carried that we proceed to elect three trustees for one year. A ballot was then taken


